

## What to Bring/What not to Bring

### ***What to Bring***

- Sleeping bag or blanket, a sheet and a pillow. Bring weather-appropriate sleepwear. The boats provide only a mattress
- Personal gear should be marked with the owner's name
- Flashlight with fresh batteries
- Personal toiletries; face cloth, towel, dental care products, prescription medicines
- Playing cards, small board games, etc.
- Money for souvenirs and snacks
- Camera, extra film

### ***What NOT to Bring***

- Alcohol and illegal substances, chewing gum or tobacco, and pets are prohibited
- Fireworks, firearms, pocketknives and Leatherman-type tools, pliers and screwdrivers. ***Anyone caught using tools to remove or deface ship items will be prosecuted***
- Smoking below decks is not permitted at any time. Smoking by adults is permitted only on shore away from building and boats
- Cell phones do not work well in the museum or on vessels.
- Air mattresses are prohibited
- Tents on site are prohibited
- "Roller sneakers" are strictly prohibited as they are a serious safety hazard. Safe, comfortable footwear is strongly encouraged
